Maintain daily log of chlorine and pH readings. If stabilizer is used record weekly. Log must be available during inspection. On days when the pool company is not servicing the pool, someone from the property should be testing the water and recording chemical readings on the pool maintenance log. Observed log recorded 3 times per week at time of inspection.

CODE REFERENCE: Maintenance Log. 64E-9.004(11). Daily record must be kept for pH and disinfectant residual tested each day the pool is open for use, and weekly for Cyanuric Acid.
